

Erasmus+ project in Estonia

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Day 1: The arrival

May 11th, 2019

At 11:30, we started our bus ride from Tartu to Tallinn to pick up the Hungarian and the Belgian exchange students from the Tallinn Airport.

The Hungarian students arrived at 14:05, after that we all went together to The Seaplane Harbour. After looking around there, we ate some lunch together and went back to the airport to pick up the Belgian students.
